Hawaii Baptist Academy is a Christian college preparatory school that equips students spiritually, intellectually, physically, socially, and emotionally, so that they bring honor to God.





# Second Quarter Begins with CEW and All-School Fellowship

#### THE MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUSES

led the way by hosting Christian Emphasis Week from October 23-27. The theme for CEW was "Wonder Why?" which is the same theme being used in the middle and high school's weekly chapel messages.

"The question 'why' is significant to all people, particularly those following Jesus. It is our hope that answering questions like 'Why church?' and 'Why Jesus?' will help our students grow in their faith," said Tony Traughber, Bible department chair.

The students attended daily chapel services and workshops that featured faith issues or provided service opportunities. The guest speaker was Emily Kiaha, East Honolulu area director for Young Life. According to a survey, one student committed their life to Christ for the first time, and nine others made recommitments. Sixty-nine students indicated they are interested in joining a small group, and 12 students requested prayer from a faculty member.

On October 25, all three schools gathered at the elementary campus to worship God and fellowship together. The all-school fellowship is a tradition that began in 2014. The purpose of this event is to celebrate being one school and the love of Jesus.

The following week, the elementary campus hosted its CEW. The theme was "Wonder."

"Building on our atmosphere of curiosity and inquisitiveness, CEW provided the time and space to look at wonder from physical, emotional, spiritual, and intellectual angles," said Cindy Gaskins, Christian Ministries coordinator at the elementary school.

Tangible expressions of the love of Jesus happened throughout the week. Students were given shoeboxes to fill with small toys and hygiene products. All shoeboxes were donated to Operation Christmas Child. Students also donated 1,017 cans and packages of food items to the food pantry at Olivet Baptist Church. On the last day of CEW, the entire elementary school participated in eight service projects at organizations within walking distance of the school. This included making and delivering cards and artwork to patients at the Rehabilitation Hospital of the Pacific

The guest speakers were Floyd and Michelle Joseph, student ministers at White's Chapel United Methodist Church in South Lake, Texas. Twenty-seven students accepted Jesus Christ for the first time, and another 46 indicated questions about what it means to follow Jesus.

THE HIGH SCHOOL BAND ROOM got a complete makeover this summer. The classroom, which is located on the third floor of the B Building, had received minor upgrades over the years. Under the direction of Brad Shimizu, the band program has been steadily growing, requiring more space and better facilities.

The room was completely stripped down. New drywall and carpeting were installed. To help absorb sound, the ceiling was raised and acoustic panels and acoustic pyramids were installed along the walls and on the ceiling. New cabinets and four sets of lockers now house students' instruments, providing much needed storage space. Additionally, the backing of each locker is designed to absorb sound, similar to the sound tiles and pyramids.

The Wind Ensemble, HBA's premiere band, is traveling to New York City to

perform at Carnegie Hall in the New York "Sounds of Spring" International Music Festival on March 28, 2018. Their performance at the festival will be preceded by a concert at an East Coast Mainland Advisory Council (MAC) event at First Baptist Church Alexandria, Virginia, on March 23. In 1973, he was appointed to a special Committee of Three (with Allen Au and Stan Sagert) to oversee the school development project and financing of the new Pali campus. The Committee served for three decades during HBA's expansion.

Rev. Hiratani held the longest pastorate in Hawaii Baptist history, having served the First Baptist Church of Pearl City when it started as a mission in 1957 until his retirement in 2003. During his 46-year ministry, he led the church in starting new churches in Hawaii and in supporting mission work in Samoa, Fiji, and Southeast Asia. 
